In 2004 the City of Manchester, New Hampshire undertook a national search to find the firm that would design the development and growth of downtown over the next ten years. After interviewing numerous firms, we selected Hillier wholeheartedly because Hillier's approach successfully integrated economics, transportation, design, quality of life, and public / private interests.

Following the initial success of our 1993 plan, community expectations were very high for a new blueprint that would guide the growth of downtown for the next decade.
